**Flora Driver Services Facility Closing Nov. 23; New Facility to Open Dec. 3**

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White announced a new Driver Services facility in Flora will open on Tuesday, Dec. 3, at 37 Greenlaw Blvd. The new facility is approximately 2,000 square feet – about 600 feet larger than the current facility at 847 E. North Ave., which is set to close on Saturday, Nov. 23.

“The new facility in Flora is larger and will be located less than 2 miles from the current facility,” said White. “In addition to the convenient location, the new facility has greater visibility and provides ample parking for the public.”

White’s office has been working with the new landlord who, as part of the 10-year lease agreement, is in charge of making necessary modifications to the building. These modifications, standard when opening a Driver Services facility at a new site, are designed to maximize the facility’s traffic flow and efficiency.

The new facility location will continue to offer the same services, some of which include: standard driver’s license and identification card renewals and first-time applications, Commercial Driver’s License (CDL) renewals, REAL ID applications, vehicle registration sticker renewals and motorcycle tests.
