Temporary Express Driver Services Facility Opening in East St. Louis on Oct. 3
CDL Drive exams will be offered at the Belleville Driver Services facility beginning Oct. 15

Illinois Secretary of State Jesse White announced his office is opening a temporary express facility in rooms 1013 and 1014 in Building A of the East St. Louis Community College Center at 601 James R. Thompson Blvd. This temporary express facility will open for business on Thursday, Oct. 3. The weekly hours of operation will be Tuesday 8 a.m.-5:30 p.m.; Wednesday through Friday 8 a.m.-5 p.m.; and Saturday 7:30 a.m.-noon.

The previous East St. Louis Driver Services facility located at 8750 Church Lane was temporarily closed on Tuesday, Sept. 24, due to air quality concerns. Secretary White emphasized his commitment to ensuring the health and safety of employees and customers. He also emphasized his commitment to keeping a Driver Services facility in East St. Louis.

“We remain committed to maintaining a Driver Services facility in East St. Louis,” said White. “In the meantime, we are pleased to provide a temporary express facility at the East St. Louis Community College Center. I appreciate and applaud the community college center for providing my office the space to conduct Secretary of State services. Our top priority is always the health, safety and welfare of our employees and customers.”
