Some Secretary of State Driver Services Facilities Closed Due to Winter Storm

Due to the hazardous road conditions caused by the ongoing winter storm, some Secretary of State Driver Services facilities have been closed for the day (Wednesday, Feb. 2). All Chicagoland metro facilities are open but have suspended road tests due to the hazardous conditions.

White advises the public to visit ilsos.gov to check the status of Driver Services facilities in their area for today and tomorrow before traveling to a local facility.

White continues to encourage people to conduct business online at ilsos.gov. In addition to driver's license and ID card renewals for those who qualify, online services include obtaining a duplicate driver's license or ID card, ordering a driver record and purchasing license plate stickers.

As a reminder, White has extended all driver's license, learner's permits and ID card expiration dates to March 31, 2022. The extension does not apply to Commercial driver's licenses (CDL) and CDL learner's permits.
